Our Summer Pony Camps are for kids 8 years old and up (camps 1 and 2). For Camp 3** kids must be 10 years old and have had 4 riding lessons here at Campbell Farms.

Students learn how to work on a farm by helping feed horses, care for them and clean stalls. They get to learn all about different horse breeds, horse health issues, parts of the horse and names of equipment used on horses. Next comes safe horse handling. Kids learn to groom, saddle, and RIDE each day!! Our program is set up to help teach kids responsibility, helps build confidence through hard work and fun activities. An all-around farm experience.

Participants get a Campbell Farm Pony camp T-Shirt, horse info packet, fun crafts, pictures from camp and a wonderful experience!! Helmets are required and provided. Long pants and riding boots, cowboy boots required.

Pony Camp Session 1 Beginner Camp

June 1st-5th Monday -Friday 8:30-11:30 am

This beginner camp focuses on the basics of horse care and safe handling, through leading, grooming, saddling, and riding horses and ponies. Students learn all about horses and they get to ride each day at camp.

Pony Camp Session 2 Paint your pony Parade and show

June 16th-20th Tuesday-Saturday 8:30-11:30 am

First time pony campers can attend this camp. Participants learn about basic horse knowledge, care and riding. Students get to paint their horse or pony and then participate in a fun parade at the farm. They also get to show off what they have learned during camp to friends and family on Saturday June 20th.

Pony Camp session 3 Trail Ride

(**Must have attended camp 1 or 2 OR taken 4 riding lessons with Campbell farms this summer. And be 10 years old)

July 13th-17th Monday- Friday 8:30-11:30 am

Students must be at least 10 years old and have attended a previous camp this year or taken 4 riding lessons this year at Campbell Farms. This is for safety. During camp, campers get to continue to work on their horse skills. Riding each day along with fun farm activities. Friday Morning July 17th we will be going on a trail ride to North Fork, just north of Pineview reservoir. Friday Morning bring a lunch and meet at the farm at 8:00 am and be back at the farm around 1:30. Parents are welcome to come hike along with us.
